# Help Us Improve Health Care Communication! Study for Adults with Down Syndrome

Are you an adult with Down syndrome establishing care with a new primary care provider? You may be eligible to participate in a research study to help improve communication between patients, supporters, and doctors.

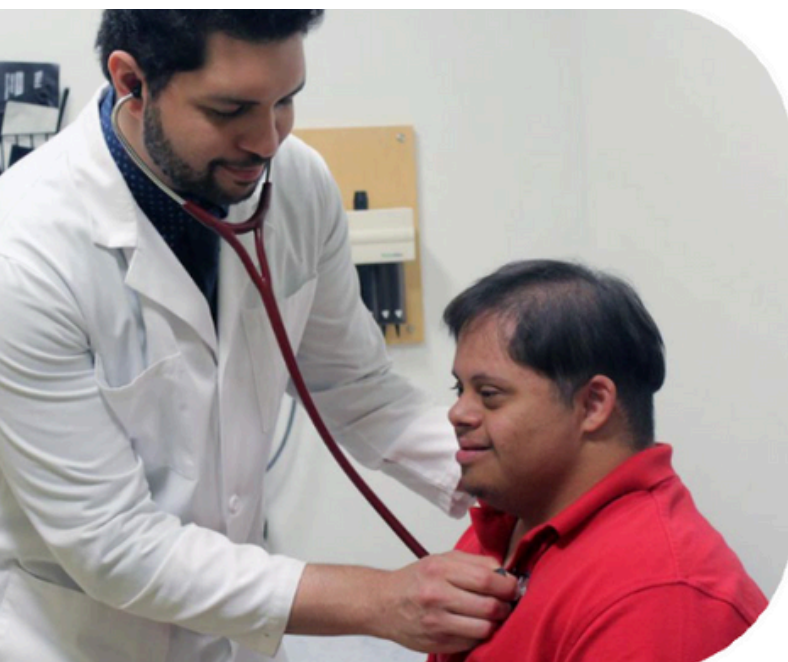
**What is the study about?** We are studying how doctors, patients with Down syndrome, and their supporters talk to each other during clinic visits. The goal is to create a communication tool that makes these visits easier and more effective.

## What will you do if you participate?

- Have your next primary care visit video and audio recorded (a small camera will be used; no extra people will be in the room).
- Complete short surveys (paper or electronic) about the visit.
- Participants will receive compensation for their time.

## Who can join?

- Adults with Down syndrome
- Their family members or supporters who attend the medical visit
- Must be able to understand and speak English
- Must be planning a new visit with a primary care provider
