Grant Proposals

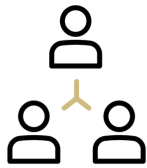

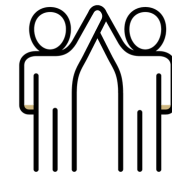
Educational Offerings
