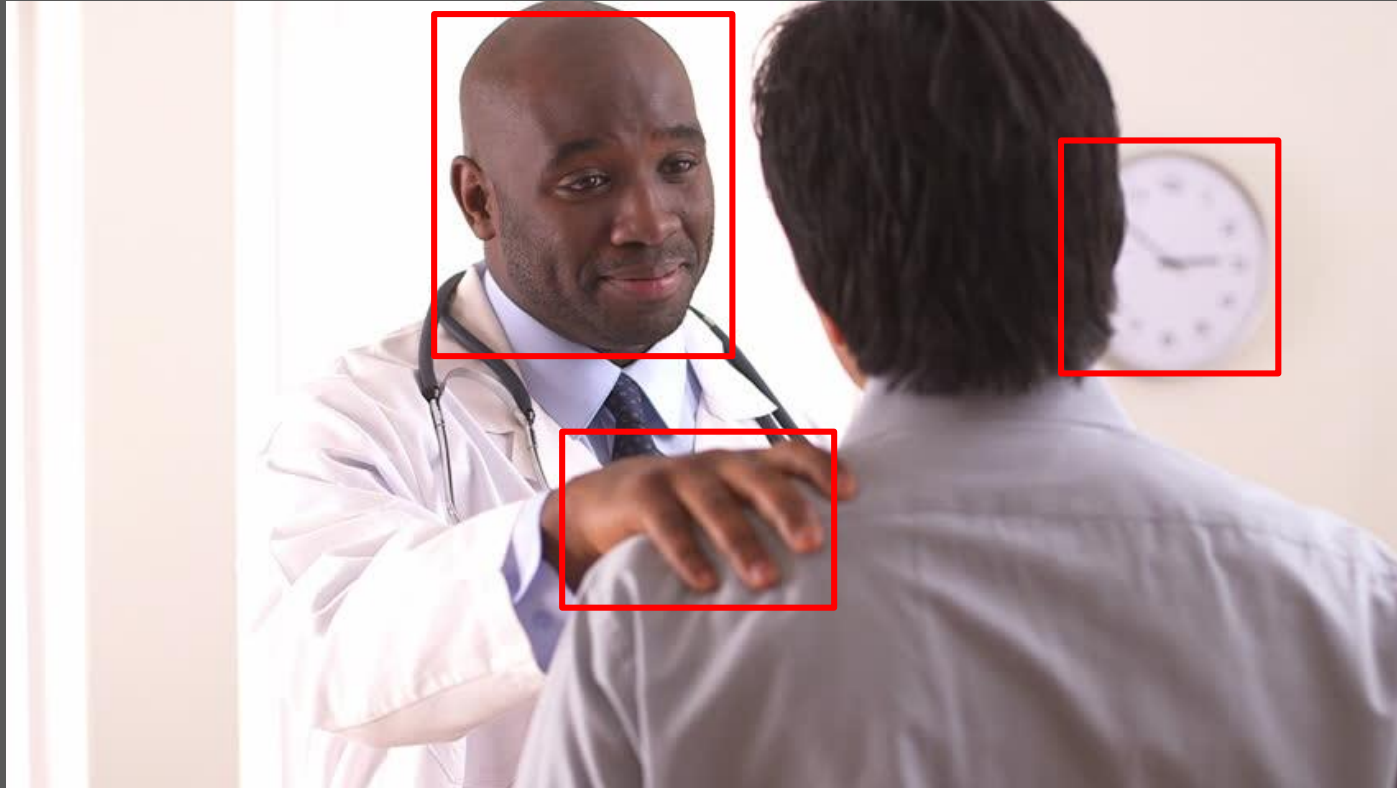

# Inclusion Criteria

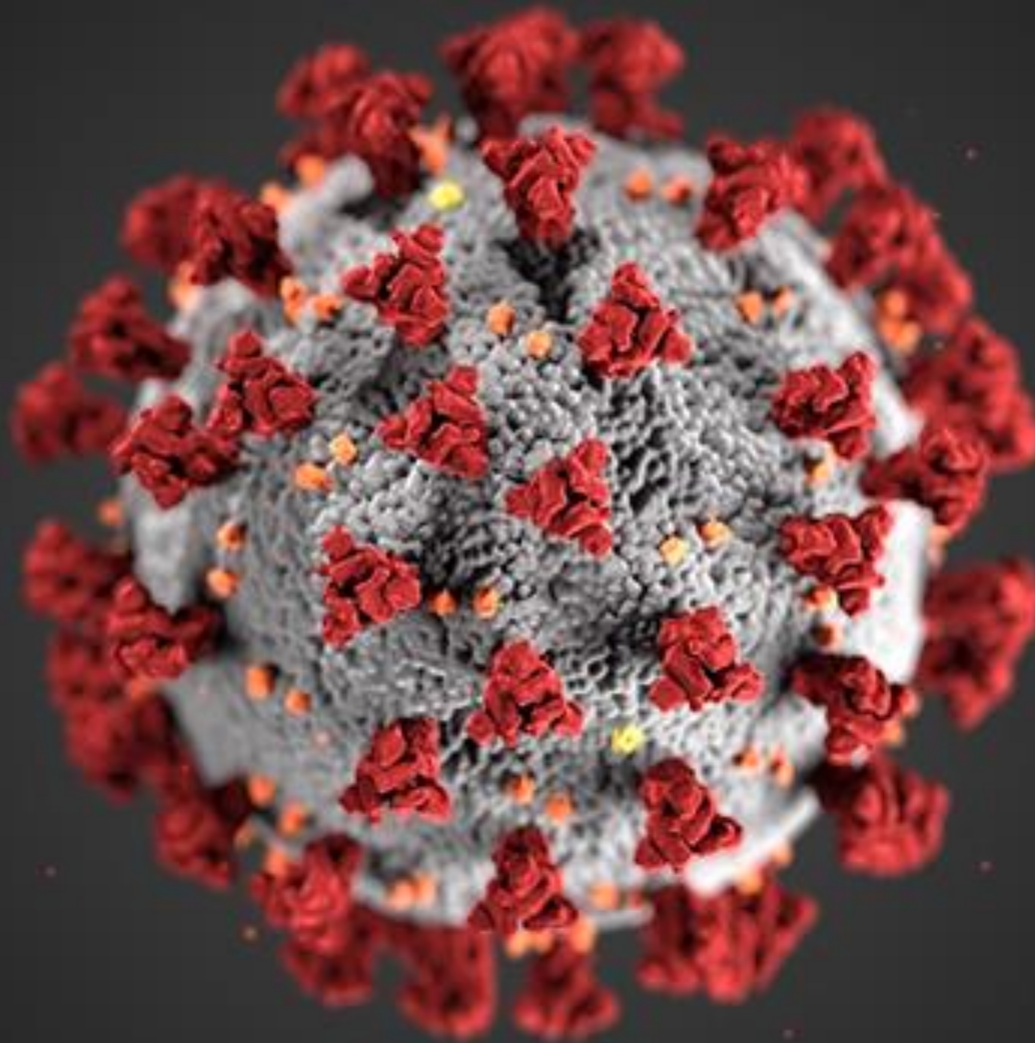
- 18-89 Years Old
- Considering Transcatheter Aortic Valve Replacement
- Prohibitive Surgical Risk (*not a candidate for surgical AVR*)
- English-Speaking (*even though we have Spanish and French Versions of the TAVR Decision Aids*)
