EXAMINING THE NEURODIVERSITY AFFIRMING NATURE OF THE FACING YOUR FEARS PROGRAM

What is the study:

- Goal: gather caregiver and autistic perspectives to enhance the neurodiversity affirming nature of the *Facing Your Fears (FYF)* program.
- Participants will complete surveys and participate in one focus group centered on gathering perspectives on neurodiversity affirming care and attitudes toward FYF.

Who can participate:

- Autistic adolescents and young adults (aged 12-19). We are looking for autistic individuals who have participated in the FYF curriculum AND autistic individuals who have no FYF experience.
- Caregivers of a child or young adult with autism. We are looking for caregivers who have participated in the FYF curriculum AND caregivers who have no FYF experience.

Participants will be compensated \$40 for participation.
