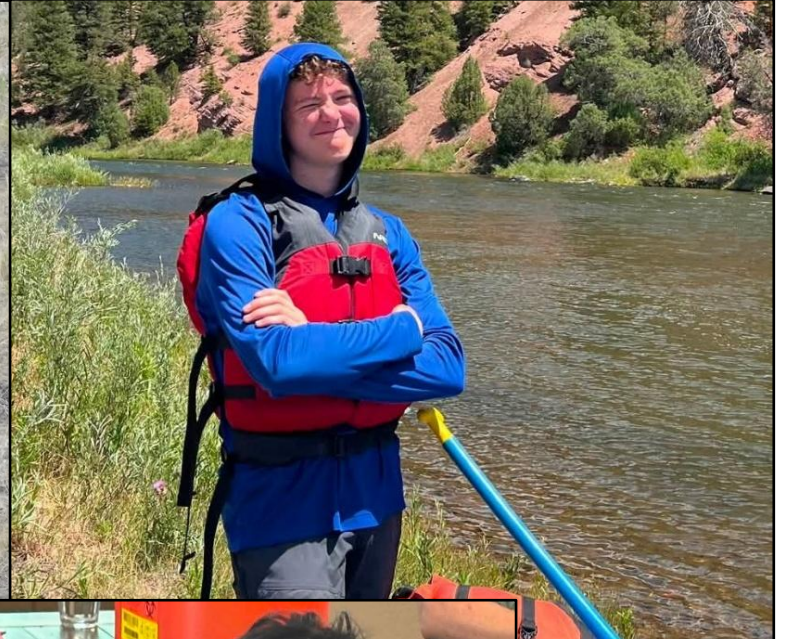

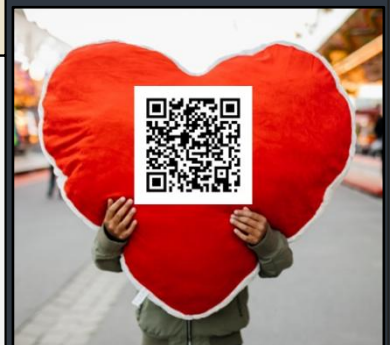
Drops of Love – CAMP VERSION
