The Amputation Rehabilitation Program at UHealth helps patients achieve their highest level of function and improve their overall quality of life by addressing their physical, emotional and day-to-day challenges associated with limb loss.

The program provides comprehensive, lifelong continuity of care and provides brace management, pre- and post-amputation support, prosthetic design and prescription, phantom pain management and long-term rehabilitation management.

Our multidisciplinary team is composed of providers from physical medicine and rehabilitation, orthopedics, social work, physical and occupational therapy, nurse navigation and rehabilitation psychology. In addition, we collaborate closely with prosthetic providers locally, regionally and across the country.

Conditions we treat:

- Limb loss due to injury, disease or congenital malformation
- Limb restoration and optimization

Services and treatments we offer:

- Amputation management including pre-amputation consultation and comprehensive post-op rehabilitation, lifelong amputation continuity of care and limb restoration and optimization.
- Assistive devices (AD), durable medical equipment (DME) and home modifications and adaptations for safety, accessibility and community reintegration.
- Emotional and psychological support for coping with limb loss, living with an amputation or limb preservation.
- Prosthetic, orthotics and bracing evaluation and prescription.
- Specialized therapy for limb loss, including occupational therapy (OT) and physical therapy (PT), prosthetic training and a personalized rehabilitation program to optimize mobility and function and improve quality of life.
- Vocational counseling, addressing return-to-work (RTW) requirements and oversight of restrictions.
